



The structure of the paper is good and explained in a lucid manner. The proposed method is interesting and the experimental results sounds convincing. Some of the modifications need to be reflected before accepting the paper for publication.

1. The authors did not mention any information regarding the implementation

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2. Add a paragraph that should explain how the proposed method achieves better performance over the counterpart scheme.
3. The Limitations of the proposed study need to be discussed before the conclusion. Please describe the limitations of your work.
4. The abstract should be extended to highlight innovations in the work. Authors should revise the keywords, and I think that these are short here for keywords.
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6. The authors may justify how the dose is optimized for the present investigation either in the materials and methods or any part of the results or discussion (either based on available literature or previous study). If from the others study should be supported with reference.
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8. The experimental results will be good to present a detailed comparison of the results. This can help to support the claim on improved results obtained with the selection methods studied. Besides, the simulation results should be analyzed, giving the reasons for the improvements claimed for each of the simulations.
9. The English need improvement since there are some grammatical and syntax errors in the manuscript.

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
