Abstract: Purpose of the Study: The purpose of this research is to compare Indonesia Islamic stock index before and during COVID-19. The paper traces the impact of the market crash towards Indonesia Islamic equity investment. Given the rise concern of the performance of Islamic equity returns, the findings in this paper are useful for investors who are interested in stock return performance and Shariah-compliant assets.

Methodology: To investigate the differences in daily equity returns of Indonesia Islamic stocks during the COVID-19 pandemic market crash, we applied one-sample paired t test by using Stata. Data collection and analysis were conducted quantitatively. We obtained daily stock prices and converted into daily returns, which was used for financial returns prior to and during COVID-19 financial market crash.

Main Findings: The result showed no significant differences before and during market crash indicates that the Indonesia Islamic stock does not react significantly to covid19 market crash. Therefore, the impact of market crash during COVID-19 outbreak on the performance of the stock returns does not apply to the Indonesia Islamic stock index.

Applications: Performance measurement is one of the major concerns for investors in Islamic capital markets. Given the rise concern of equity assets in Islamic finance in general and in the performance of Islamic equity returns in particular, the findings in this paper are useful for investors who are interested with stock return performance as well as Shariah-compliant assets.

Novelty/Originality: This paper contributes to the assessment of Islamic financial assets under financial market crisis, as this research mainly focused on the short-term analysis before and during the COVID-19 market crash.

Considering that during the observed period, the Islamic financial market growth has been severely impacted due to COVID-19 lockdowns.
