Which ETFs Adopt A Green Concept's Review : Cases in Indonesia

Abstract

This research is a qualitative research that explores the ETF Mutual Funds Indonesia which adopts a sustainable green concept. data collected through direct observation of ETF objects through documentation available in the annual annual reports of issuers that issue shares with a green concept, composition of ETF Mutual Funds portfolio effects taken from the perspective report of mutual funds with a green concept, from 40 ETF populations during 2021-2022 Those listed and actively traded on the IDX obtained 38 samples using purposive sampling with certain criteria and the composition of the ETF portfolio effects was predominantly dominated by 31 issuers, and there were only 22 who did not apply the green concept in their companies, meaning that only 9 issuers had a green concept in their companies. they are ASII, BBKA, BBNI, BBRI, BRPT, TOWR, UNTR and UNVR.
