



The Linkages Among Coal Mining Activity And Other Sectors In Kutai Kartanegara Regency

This study aimed to analyze the linkages among economic activities in the form of backward linkage, forward linkage, employment multiplier and income multiplier and the other sectors in the mining of coal in Kutai Kartanegara regency. This study used secondary data (Input-Output Table) which consists of ten economic sectors in the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) and supporting data from Related Agencies in Kutai Regency. The results showed that the forward linkage and backward linkage of coal mining were categorized as weak compared with the other sectors. The total employment multiplier and income multiplier had relatively high classification. The evaluation of the results showed that the environmental impact of the coal mining sector on the economy of Kutai Kartanegara Regency still needed to be improved. The role of the coal mining sector was quite significant in forming the economic output.
